

SUPERVISOR'S REPORT: AN UPDATE TO THE COMMUNITY

April 17, 2020



I wanted to update you on what has been happening in Northville Township and our local area.

COVID-19 Impact:

- As of April 17: Wayne County (excluding City of Detroit) has 5,625 confirmed COVID cases and 436 Deaths: Northville Township has 81 confirmed cases and 9 deaths.
- In the last 14 days, Our Fire Department has been on 130 calls with 57 being COVID related. The per day average is 9 total calls with 4 COVID positive. The average COVID response call takes two hours of responder time.
- In the last 14 days, Our Police Department has received 2,828 calls through the dispatch center with 92 being COVID related. The per day average is 218 total calls and 75 calls for service with 7 being COVID related.

Some good news:

- 68.6% of Northville Township residents have already completed the Census. This exceeds Wayne County (52.2%) and the State of Michigan (55.7%) averages. There is still time to complete your census - visit census2020.gov to get started! Let's make it 100%!
- Our very own ZF North America has partnered w/Pontiac, Michigan-based manufacturer Detroit Sewn to help with the fight against the Covid-19 virus. A shipment of 100,000 face masks is expected by the end of April.
- Since the Township Offices are closed, the payment dead line for water and sewer bills is extended to June 5 to assist our residents and business owners.

What we are ALL DOING TOGETHER is working. Please continue to stay home and be safe, which helps protect our First Responders.
