

§67-31 Assault and battery; threatening language

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person within the Township to attempt or offer with force and violence to do a corporate hurt to another or to assault and/or batter any other person or to cause, engage in or provoke any disturbance or fight or brawl or to direct threatening language or fighting words toward and person in any public or private place. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this section shall be subjected to a maximum fine of \$500.00 and/or a maximum imprisonment of 93 days.
- B. An individual who assaults or assaults and batters his or her spouse or former spouse, an individual with whom he or she has or has had a dating relationship, an individual with whom he or she has had a child in common, or a resident or former resident of his or her household, is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 93 days or a fine of not more than \$500.00, or both.
